Retrofit of existing floor of an office building to house the corporate headquarters and production offices of this independent, high-profile weekly newspaper. Growth over the past two decades, along with sale of its midtown Manhattan headquarters and radio station, permitted the design of new offices and publishing facilities on the lower East Side of New York City.

Working with Amie Gross Architects, Acoustic Distinctions provided design input and technology systems design for recording and internet broadcasting studios, as well as private offices and open plan work areas. A small multipurpose Gallery, along with conference facilities to connect the national and internal Board of Directors, completes the facility.

The Forward, published weekly since 1990 with online content added daily to www.forward.com, is widely regarded as the essential, independent source of news, arts and opinion for American Jews. The English language edition grew out of the legendary Yiddish Jewish Daily Forward, founded in 1897. The Forward is committed to rigorous reporting and balanced, thoughtful commentary on news, politics and culture in the Jewish world. Headquartered in New York, the newspaper is owned by the Forward Association, Inc., a not-for-profit, 501(c)(3) organization.
