Renovation of the 170,000 SF building involved retro-fit and repurposing spaces on this four-floor building which houses lecture rooms, breakout rooms, conference rooms, an atrium, offices, student lounge and locker room. The upper level also includes a Corporate Education Center.

The renovation also included construction of a new bridge which connects the upper two levels of the graduate school building to an existing building on the opposite side of main pedestrian traffic lane. The houses administrative offices, including the Business School Deans Office on the upper level.

AD provided acoustic consulting services relating to room acoustics and sound isolation throughout the building, with special attention to Cohort Rooms, Classrooms, the Forum, and executive offices and conference rooms. Scope also included addressing traffic noise for offices in the bridge structure, mechanical equipment noise, and specifying appropriate operable walls dividing classroom spaces.
