PS 21 PERFORMANCE SPACE FOR THE 21ST CENTURY

A performance space dedicated to presenting and nurturing the performing arts of dance, music, theater and film in a natural setting sought options for transitioning from its decade-long home in a tent to a more permanent structure. AD's team provided feasibility study and consulting services to program and generate a conceptual design for replacing the existing concert tent with a 28,420-SF performing arts building. Challenges included working within a limited 19,930 SF footprint and increasing seat capacity from 300 to 405.

The main building, like the tent, will be used for music, dance, film and other performing arts programs. In addition to its use for public performances, building will also accommodate instructional, rehearsal, meetings and other related purposes. Services included interfacing with local authorities and addressing citizen concerns of venue's noise propagation.
