



MUSIC AND THEATRE PERFORMANCE SPACES

ALBANY STATE UNIVERSITY FINE ARTS CENTER

New 80,300 GSF state-of-the-art building supports music and theatre students in their development of talent to the fullest. The building consists of a, 100-seat choral rehearsal/recital hall, an avant-garde “Black Box” multipurpose theatre, instructional spaces, a band rehearsal room, a percussion/chamber ensemble room, percussion practice rooms, faculty studios, and Wenger practice modules.

Acoustic design included elements to enable the rehearsal and performance spaces to accommodate a wide variety of musical and theatrical genres. Adjustable curtains were incorporated along the walls to enable adjusting reverberation to the appropriate liveness for a given ensemble. Special door sound seals were incorporated to enhance the learning and performance environment for students and faculty, preventing distraction by intrusive noise from adjacent critical spaces. The mechanical systems were designed to achieve quietness in the most critical spaces.
