Adaptive re-use of 68,000 SF of space on Steiner Studios Brooklyn Navy Yard campus transforms what originally served as warehouse space to a state of the art school cinema. Facilities cover two floors and include soundstages, photo studios, post-production spaces, set-construction shops, wardrobe workshops and other spaces for TV and film production.

Academic programs for screenwriting, directing, cinematography and other film-related disciplines are supported through the specialized spaces cited above as well as lecture, seminar and classrooms, conference rooms and screening room. Located on the complex of the largest film and studio complex outside Hollywood, the facility offers entirely digital production and post-production environment, state-of-the-art workspaces, studios, stages and equipment. Students can create in a fully professional setting and have convenient access to industry professionals for invaluable collaborative opportunities.
