

NEW WORSHIP SANCTUARY

HILLSONG CHURCH

New 3,500-seat sanctuary accommodates one of Australia's fastest growing churches with a congregation of more than 14,000 people. The new sanctuary auditorium offers the ability to broadcast high quality shows and services with and features outstanding acoustics, lighting, audio visual and data cabling.

AD's team assisted during the planning and programming process in advising on strategic choices for space layout and configurations as they relate to supporting a positive acoustic environment for the worship setting. Specific items addressed included criteria for achieving low background noise from mechanical/electrical equipment, accommodations for sound isolation between adjacent spaces as the main auditorium has the ability to be divided into nine classrooms. Architectural acoustic recommendations were provided in close collaboration with audio system design to allow the large room to convey a sense of envelopment supportive of worship while also support speech and musical aspects of worship services.
