



COMMUNICATION ARTS MEDIA ART SPACES

As part of a \$10 M, 70,000 SF renovation of McCuan Hall, existing spaces in the classroom building were repurposed to accommodate specialized spaces for Media Arts program. Spaces included video production, video editing, mass media, film, public speaking, screening and TV studio operations.

AD addressed acoustics needs which included acoustic survey, design criteria and detail design elements.

This work was performed in conjunction with improvements to attached Smith Theatre which is a 420-seat multi-purpose auditorium used for student, community and partner events. Services in the theatre centered on achieving low background noise through close coordination with mechanical/electrical engineers in designing HVAC system replacements covering the stage and seating house.
