



LARGE MULTI-PURPOSE PERFORMANCE VENUE

PERFORMANCE HALL & UNIVERSITY CENTER

New 147,000-SF center provides performance and academic spaces for University’s music, theatre and visual arts departments. The Center’s crown jewel is a 1,100-seat performance hall with world class acoustics, a pipe organ, and adjustable features that support the school’s vision for a broad range of programs to supplement concerts. In addition to music, The 45,000 SF Hall serves as a venue for theater, experimental audio-visual, lectures, traveling shows, and worship. AD’s team carried a leadership role in program development and concept design for the Hall and music department spaces. Department spaces include several large rehearsal rooms and a recital hall.

Services extended through construction. Acoustic, performance audio and AV systems were strategically designed to support the Center’s goal of fostering stronger levels of engagement with culture and inspiring positive change.

Other hall features include a large stage with the capacity to accommodate a full orchestra of 90 musicians, and an upper balcony above the orchestra which can hold a large choir. The design also required a deliberate approach for sound isolations as academic spaces are located adjacent to the performance hall, facilitating student circulation and access to rehearsal spaces.
