Acoustic review of construction documents for a presentation theater in the University's new visitor resource center. The theater is the setting for campus visitors to view orientation videos and live presentations regarding campus events/activities as well as occasional music performances. Secondary use of the space involves opening operable partitions to accommodate special events and larger receptions within the building.

The unique round aesthetic for the theater raised concern for the space's acoustics. Acoustic Distinctions provided a comprehensive design review and developed recommendations for accommodating acoustic challenges. Prescribed solutions included addition of sound absorptive material, including installation of a heavy velour stage drapery on a curved track.
