New 300 seat auditorium serves as an assembly space for magnet school dedicated to health science curriculum. Built adjacent to Queens Hospital Center, auditorium serves both educational purposes for the 800-student high school and for professional healthcare seminars and symposiums for the neighboring hospital staff.

Services included acoustics and coordination of acoustics with performance systems design. Challenges included accommodating the space's effectiveness for both lectures and student music recitals. Services extended to associated spaces in the 126,000 SF school including a choral room, classroom and gymnasium.
