New 26,000-SF theme restaurant occupies two floors of building in the heart of New York City's Times Square. Seating 800 diners, acoustic consulting addressed activity noise control / room acoustics and sound separations between food production and patron areas. Restaurant interiors feature bar seating areas, open kitchens, mezzanine level and interconnection with spiral stair case. In addition to advising on interior treatments to accommodate suitable room acoustics, expertise was directed to noise and vibration control for building HVAC systems, kitchen ventilation systems and three elevators.

The interior design was specifically designed to align with the dynamic setting of New York City's Time's Square while offering a pleasant respite from the urban hustle bustle.
