NEW MUSIC AND PERFORMANCE COMMONS

WEITZ CENTER FOR CREATIVITY

\$28M expansion project involved a 56,000 SF addition to the existing Weitz Center to provide 21st Century facilities to serve the Music Department's academic and performance needs. AD was engaged for acoustics and AV system consulting and design as part of a design/build project. The effort entailed expanding the south east corner of the Weitz Center to provide performance spaces, rehearsal spaces, teaching studios and practice rooms.

AD's team provided design criteria and maintained involvement through an integrated design approach in addressing needs to achieve strong performance and learning environment for:

- 400-seat performance / concert hall – high acoustic quality; able to support staged dance productions
- Center's interdisciplinary functionality for collaboration among art disciplines and other curriculum areas
- Large instrumental rehearsal room
- Mid size rehearsal room / recital space; flexible to accommodate varying sized groups and function as small performance and master class spaces with seating for less than 100
- Small rehearsal space for chamber music
- Offices / music faculty studios and small practice rooms
