KENNEDY CENTER FOR THEATRE & STUDIO ARTS

New \$46.8 M, 86,400-SF facility houses two performance spaces (175-seat theatre and black box theatre) with their respective back of house support spaces, recording suite, computer classrooms and a video production room complete with a green screen, overhead lighting, a camera and playback monitor and studio space for radio drama.

Acoustic expertise supporting the 72,000 GSF building addition housing the College's new flexible performance spaces centered on performance environments and respective back of the house support spaces. Acoustic design was also provided for seminar room connected to the acting studio for playwriting, digital teaching studios, screening room, studio and audio production areas, faculty offices and public spaces.

AV system design featured integrated control system with tie-in of studios, rehearsal spaces and performance spaces to recording suite. Classroom technology included content sharing capabilities to foster strong levels of collaboration and artistic creativity.
