

MUSIC, THEATRE AND DANCE

JANET WALLACE FINE ARTS CENTER

This phased project updates facilities to better support music, theatre, dance and art. The first phase includes a 110,000-SF renovation and expansion of the music and fine arts wings. Reusing the existing 1960's concrete structure, design team worked closely with college to integrate existing structure renovations with new construction to house 350-seat recital/concert hall, faculty studios, practice rooms and new state-of-the-art Instrumental and Choral Rehearsal Rooms. Accommodating a diverse music program, performance and rehearsal spaces incorporated adjustable acoustic elements.

Future phases include an additional 70,000-SF theater building renovation including a 280-seat Main Stage, a 150-seat flexible theater, new dance studios, practice rooms and office spaces.
