NAISMITH BASKETBALL HALL OF FAME

New landmark structure offers more than 80,000 SF of flexible function space and includes 40,000 SF of exhibit space celebrating basketball history. Facilities include 200-seat theater, retail space, gift shop, exhibition galleries and in the heart of the building, Center Court, is a basketball court that also serves as an atrium/meeting area. While primarily billed as an entertainment complex, the Hall hosts hundreds of local and global corporate meetings, award dinners, private socials and internationally televised events.

Acoustic expertise was directed to fine-tune core and shell design for the overall facility and room acoustics for the theater space. Two theater walls abutting to adjacent parking garage required additional measures for sound isolation. AD also addressed noise and vibration control from mechanical and electrical systems.
