New 400-seat Chapel sits on the majestic cliffs of Newport, Rhode Island and serves one of the Country's most prestigious Catholic Universities. Over time, with student population increases, the school had outgrown their existing chapel and needed a new space.

In addition to the chapel's primary function of congregational worship and masses, it serves as a space for classical music concerts, weddings, baptisms, conferences and seminars. Among other spaces in the building are a special prayer room, offices and a common room which will serve as a student center.

AD worked with the design team on details to enable the space to be an inspiring setting for worship and music performance. Additional coordination of audio/video systems, and lighting increased the functionality of the space to serve as an additional resource for the University for enhancing the student experience.
