The new 92,000-SF building serves as a hub for interdisciplinary performing arts disciplines and centralizes performance and support spaces for theater and dance departments. Specific elements include a new proscenium theater, a black box theater, dance performance space, movement studios, dance studios, lighting labs, a costume shop, a set shop, computer labs, classrooms, recording studio and a new food service venue.

Spaces were specifically designed to enable greater collaboration among students in theater, dance and music and support the University's goal of integrating technology in the performing arts.

Center also caters to the local community for use during summer months serving community organizations and performing arts students across the state of New York.
