ENGLISH AUDITORIUM

Revitalization of auditorium originally constructed in 1913. The room was outdated and was used for pipe organ practice, but was otherwise underutilized. The University wanted to expand the room's versatility to include special events, and large lecture classes. AD designed new lighting and AV systems to support these new uses. We also found many opportunities for acoustical improvements associated with the room's updating, including variable acoustics banners. These banners, when retracted provide a more reverberant environment to support organ practice than pre-renovation, but provide for a superior and more controlled acoustic environment for the expanded program when extended.
