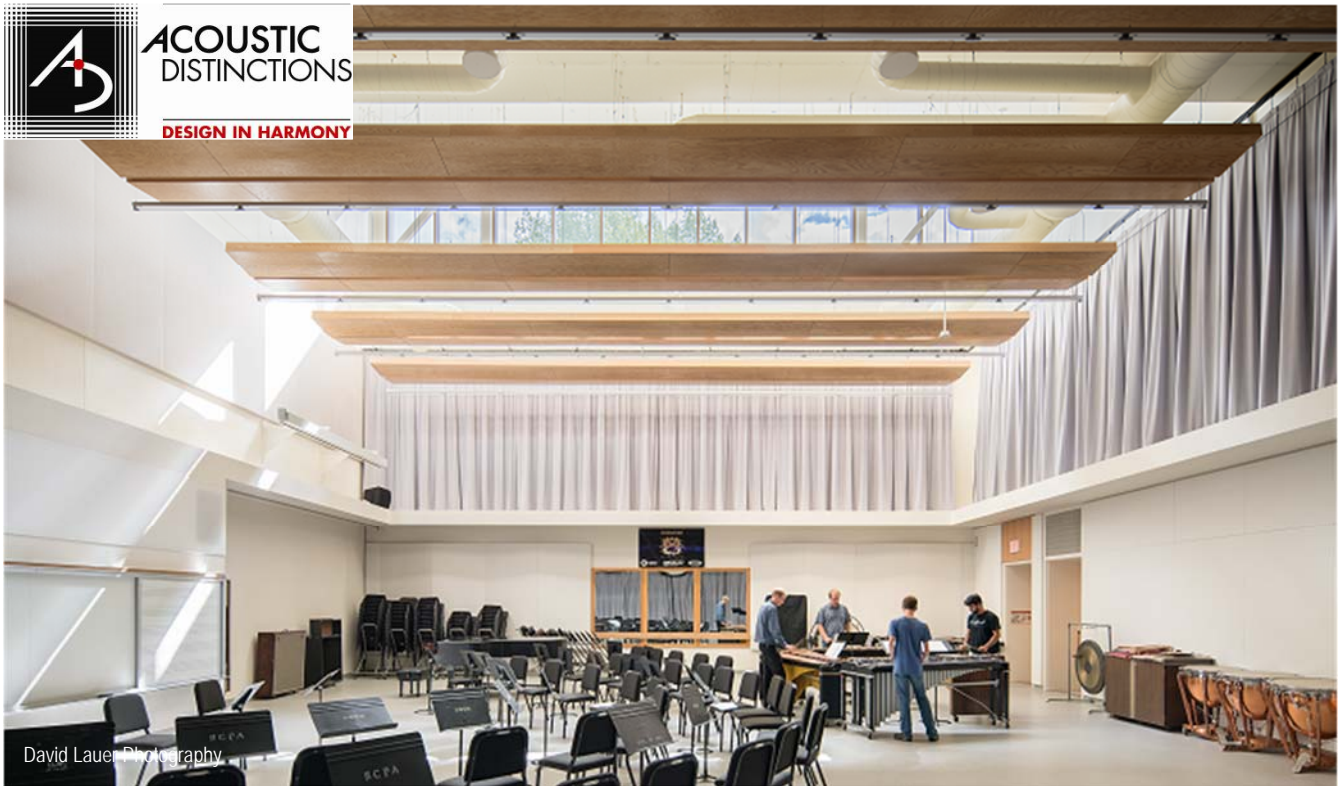

MUSIC, THEATRE AND DANCE

FINE ARTS CENTER

Renovation of an existing 120,000-SF facility and a new 50,000 SF addition accommodates increased enrollment and growing reputation of UWY's fine arts program. Spaces include new performance spaces, large teaching laboratory / studios, faculty offices and student practice rooms.

AD's expertise centered on room design input for acoustically sensitive spaces (concert hall, recital hall, rehearsal spaces and classrooms) and overall sound isolation and noise and vibration control for the entire Center. AD's involvement spanned early planning stages and reconciling budgeting challenges for incorporating end-user wish list with budgeting parameters.

A/V system design included planning, detailing, specification and commissioning for spaces including the sound lab, rehearsal areas, performance spaces, dance studios, teaching labs, recording studio, Thrust Theater, classrooms, seminar/conference rooms, and computer labs/design studios.
